Blackbox solutions introduced the ROVACOM as the worlds first Diagnostic tool for Land Rover vehicles available to independent repair specialists In 1999. Right from the outset it was a tool that was way ahead of its time and even today, clones of it are still being marketed. It's software underwent many updates and it even had a hardware update from MK1 to MK2 in its life and was eventually discontinued in 2003 after introduction of the ROVACOM PRO system. Over the following years many ROVACOM owners traded their systems in for the PRO which means we have a small supply of used ROVACOMS. These have been fully tested and refurbished where required and come complete with all leads, manuals, power supplies and other required accessories. They are all licensed and programmed for the following vehicle systems.

The second generation MK II ROVACOM - £3,200.00 - Introduced over 2 years ago, to replace the MK 1, and with a slightly faster processor, the **MK II ROVACOMS** have proved their worth in the field. Other than the addition of an Aluminum heat sink on the rear, the MK II looks and feels exactly the same as a MK 1 and is functionally the same. We have very few of these in stock.
