



The ROVACOM LITE is a system which was specifically designed right from scratch for private owners, enthusiasts and other DIY mechanics.

First launched in July 2003 at the Billing Land Rover show in the UK, it amazed everyone, not only because it employed such innovative web browser technology, but because a base system could be purchased for only a few hundred pounds. It was the first time that such a professional feature rich diagnostic system, with capabilities at least equal to dealer equipment had been brought below several thousand pounds and many were quick to snap one up.

After four years of success seeing many hundreds of systems sold all over the world and quite a few upgrades and improvements to the software, the vehicle server was eventually withdrawn from sale in June 2007 and replaced with the **FAULTMATE SV** and **FAULTMATE MV** systems. While the ROVACOM LITE could be purchased quite cheaply as a start up system and then expanded if desired, the **FAULTMATE SV** is purchased as an all in one system with all required hardware and software supplied for a single vehicle at a lower cost than even a basic ROVACOM LITE. The **FAULTMATE MV** system continues to be sold in the same modular form as the ROVACOM LITE was, although it has other physical improvements.

Because the **FAULTMATE** systems both use the same modules and Vehicle Explorer software as the ROVACOM LITE, there is naturally no change in respect of future upgrade production. The Interfaces and leads are also more or less identical and so continue to be produced.
